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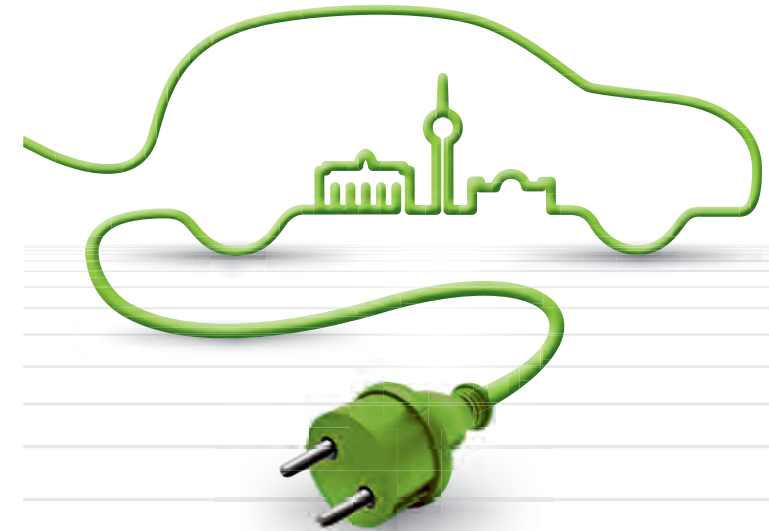

Berlin-Brandenburg Model for Electromobility

The capital region of Germany is already a pioneer in innovative and sustainable mobility. With more than 100 projects, more than 1.500 e-vehicles and over 400 public charging points, it is the country's largest laboratory for electromobility – and is leading the way in Europe.

These projects cover a broad spectrum of applications for integrated mobility options and future-oriented drive systems: from motorized vehicles for private households to fleets of carsharing, public transportation and commercial vehicles, as well as electric freight transport by truck, van and cargo bike. Concepts and strategies integrate vehicles into transportation and energy systems, i. e. they go beyond individual automobiles to pursue user-friendly, multi-modal systems linked with the use and storage of renewable energies.

Research, develop, produce, educate, apply

The capital region Berlin-Brandenburg aims to become an internationally recognized model for electromobility in Europe. The entire value-added chain for electromobility is to be situated in this region, with everything from research, development and production to education and application.

eMO is coordinating the "Berlin-Brandenburg International Showcase for Electromobility", which is being sponsored by the federal government and the states of Berlin and Brandenburg for a period of three years. With more than 100 partners, this showcase is putting around 30 projects into practice.

Action Plan for Electromobility 2020

The capital region uses active the chances of electromobility and creates the necessary framework.

Together with partners from business, science, government and administration, eMO has developed an electromobility strategy ("Action Plan for Electromobility 2020") that will establish Berlin-Brandenburg as an internationally recognized model for electromobility in Europe.

The Action Plan builds i.a. on the industrial master plans and the joint innovation strategy for the states of Berlin and Brandenburg.
